



2021 FSYP Art Contest

2021 Theme: "My Favorite Place In the World....."

Deadline: Original Art Postmarked by Wednesday, March 17, 2021

Prizes:

- There are three prizes in each of three age categories, nine prizes in all.
- Age categories are 5-8, 9-12, and 13-18.
- The following prizes will be awarded in each age category: 1st place: \$500 2nd place: \$250 3rd place: \$100
- All nine winners will be honored at the Youth Awards Ceremony in June.

Eligibility:

- All FSYP contests are open to children of U.S. Foreign Affairs agency officials who are eligible for overseas assignment and who report to the Chief of Mission when at post.
- Family members of officers, directors, major contributors, employees, and members of any selection committee are not eligible to participate.
- Applicant must be under 19 and their family must be a current member of FSYP as of March 17, 2021. To join FSYP please see our website at: www.fsyf.org
- A contestant may submit only one entry per contest.

Artwork Specifications:

- Artwork must address the given theme.
- Only flat media will be accepted.
- Any medium (pastel, watercolor, oil, pencil, crayon, digital art, etc.) is acceptable.
- Submissions must be entirely or essentially the artist's original work. Found material such as bits of wallpaper, photographs or printed matter may be used, e.g., in a collage, but must be presented in an original way in the context of an essentially new composition.
- Dimensions of submitted work may not exceed 22" x 28".

Use of Artwork:

- Artwork will become the property of FSYP and/or SDFCU and will not be returned to artist. FSYP may use submitted artwork in FSYP-related publicity or products and retains the right to sell the artwork for fund-raising purposes.

Submitting Artwork:

- Please email the Art Contest entry form and a photo of your artwork to FSYP@FSYP.org by March 17, 2021.
- Once you email your art and entry form, you will receive a confirmation email with the address to mail the original art. The original art **MUST** be postmarked by March 17, 2021.
- Any late submissions will **NOT** be judged.
